

Recycle **Political Yard Signs and Light Bulbs** **November 15 and 18, 2020**

Stockton United Methodist Church celebrates America Recycles Day, a nationwide initiative every November 15 by Keep America Beautiful.

Recycle all kinds of political yard signs (steel stands, paper and plastic signs) and residential light bulbs on Sunday, November 15, 9:30-10:45 a.m. or the following Wednesday, November 18, 2-4 p.m.

Recycle these bulbs for free:

- compact fluorescents (CFLs)
- incandescent
- halogen
- light emitting diodes (LEDs)

Recycle these mercury-containing bulbs for a fee that passes directly to the companies that extract mercury, a complicated procedure for processing hazardous materials.

- florescent tubes—\$1/tube
- metal halide—\$2.50/bulb

Drive into the SUMC east portico for a masked Go Green Team volunteer to safely collect your signs and bulbs from your trunk or back seat. Please stay in your car and do not unload them yourself.

To safely transport CFLs and metal halide bulbs, seal each one in a zip-lock bag, one per bag.

Transport florescent tubes in the box the new ones came in (you can take your box back home) or carefully wrap them in newspaper or other protective material that prevents them from sliding out.

We cannot accept broken bulbs. For safety, we cannot store bulbs in the church at any other time so please drop them off only Sunday, November 15, 9:30-10:45 a.m. or the following Wednesday, November 18, 2-4 p.m.

SUMC is located east of the square on Hwy. MO-32 at the intersection of Hwy. J.
